

ROGERS FREE LIBRARY LIBRARY SERVICE POLICIES

Rogers Free Library provides materials and resources for the information, entertainment, intellectual development, and enrichment needs of the community. The Library shall endeavor to:

1. Select, organize, and make available print, non-print, and electronic materials.
2. Provide assistance and guidance to all patrons seeking those materials.
3. Sponsor and implement displays, exhibits, book lists, programs, etc., that appeal to children, young adults, and adults.
4. Cooperate with other agencies and organizations that serve the community, whenever the need arises.
5. Secure information outside the library's own resources when requested (using interlibrary loan and other resource sharing methods provided through OSL, the State, and beyond).
6. Lend to other libraries in OSL, HELIN, and others upon request.
7. Develop and provide services/materials to patrons with special needs (e.g. those in care facilities).
8. Cooperate with – but not perform the functions of – school and other institutional libraries
9. Provide service during hours which best meet the needs of the community, including evenings and Saturdays.
10. Use media and other public relations resources to promote the full range of available library services.

(Periodically, review library services being offered with the goal of enhancing some, creating new ones to meet specific needs, and retiring those no longer deemed necessary).
